- 3. Label the Pacific and Atlantic Oceans
- 4. The Andes Mountain Range runs parallel to the Pacific coast. They are the tallest mountains in the western hemisphere. Find and label them with ^^^^^^ on the map.
- 5. Find and label by name and with a blue lines the following river system. It is the second largest in South America after the Amazon and empties into the Atlantic Ocean. (The Paraná, the Paraguay, the Uruguay, and the Río de la Plata)
- 6. Between Bolivia and Peru lies one of the few large lakes in South America call Lake Titicaca. Find the location of this lake, draw a blue dot and label the lake by name.
