There are 11 countries in East Africa. Find each of the countries below. Shade each country in a different color on the map and make the map key match. Write the initials of each country on the map. (Don't use blue for the countries.)

Find, shade blue, and label by name the following lakes: Lake Victoria, Lake Tanganyika, Lake Malawi

Find, draw, shade blue, and label by name the following lakes: Lake Tana in Ethiopia, Lake Turkana in Kenya.

Find, draw, and label the Nile River with a blue line from its start in Burundi to Lake Victoria to the Mediterranean Sea.

Add the Blue Nile from its start at Lake Tana in Ethiopia.

Label the Atlantic Ocean, the India Ocean, the Gulf of Aden, the Mediterranean Sea, the Arabian Sea, and the Red Sea

Part of the Sahara Desert is located in East Africa. Locate and circle the Sahara Desert on the map. Put dots inside the circle to represent sand. It includes the northern parts of Mauritania, Mali, Niger, Chad and Sudan. It includes the southern parts of Morocco, Algeria, Libya, Tunisia, and Egypt.

The highest point in Africa is **Mt. Kilimanjaro** in between Kenya and Tanzania.
