2	The First Fleet carried criminals from the British Isles to Australia and made the island a prison colony.
3	A settlement began to form in Sydney and the city became a busy center of trade and industry.
4	Gold was discovered near Bathurst, New South Wales.
5	Captain Cook explored the islands of New Zealand and told the British government that they would be good places to colonize.
6	Maori leaders signed the Treaty of Waitangi. It gave control of New Zealand to Great Britain in exchange for protection and land rights.
7	Many Maori were killed in the conflict between the Maori and the British.
8	The British colonies in Australia unified to establish the Commonwealth of Australia.
9	New Zealand became the first country in the world to give women the legal right to vote.
10	Australia, New Zealand, and the United States signed a mutual security treaty called the ANZUS Pact.
