There are 7* countries in North Africa. Find each of the countries listed below. Shade and label each country by name on the map.

*Morocco may look like 2 different countries on the map because it claims Western Sahara as a territory. Label Western Sahara and shade it the same color as Morocco. The Canary Islands off the coast of Morocco are part of Spain.

Canary Island, Western Sahara, Morocco, Algeria, Tunisia, Libya, and Egypt

Find the capital city for each country, except Western Sahara and the Canary Islands and label it with a star and by name.

Find, draw, and label the Nile River with a blue line from its start in Burundi to Lake Victoria to the Mediterranean Sea.

Add the Blue Nile from its start at Lake Tana in Ethiopia.

Find and label the Suez Canal and the Strait of Gibraltar.

Label the Atlantic Ocean, the India Ocean, the Mediterranean Sea, the Arabian Sea, and the Red Sea.

Part of the Sahara Desert is located in East Africa. Locate and circle the Sahara Desert on the map. Put dots inside the circle to represent sand. It includes the northern parts of Mauritania, Mali, Niger, Chad and Sudan. It includes the southern parts of Morocco, Algeria, Libya, Tunisia, and Egypt.

Label the cities of Benghazi, Libya and Alexandria, Egypt.

Circle the Sinai Peninsula, it is part of Egypt but considered part of Asia.

Find the Atlas Mountain Range and label it by name and with ^^^^^ to symbolize mountain.
