2. Find the following islands. (Lakshadweep, Andaman, Nicobar) They are part of India so shade them the same color you did India.

3. Find and label the capital city of each country with a star and the name of the capital city.

4. Find and label with a dot and with its name the following 2 cities in India: Mumbai(Bombai) Kolkata (Calcuta)

5. Label the following bodies of water: India Ocean, Bay of Bengal, and Arabian Sea

6. Find and draw a blue line for the following 3 rivers on the map. Label them with a blue line and by name.

- the Indus River in Pakistan - the Ganges River in India - the Brahmaputra north of Nepal and Bhutan
