There are 10 countries in the southern most region of the continent of Africa. It also included 4 independent island countries, and 2 French Island territories. Shade or outline each country in a distinct color on the map and make the map key match. Write the initials of each country on the map inside or by the country.

Find and label with blue line the following rivers: Zambezi, Limpopo, Malawi

Find the Victoria Falls on the Zambezi river on the border between Zambia and Zimbabwe. Create a symbol for the mile long 350 feet high water fall and put it on the map at the location of the falls.

Label the Atlantic Ocean, and the India Ocean.

Find and label the Cape of Good Hope. This is southernmost tip of the continent and is considered the place where the two oceans meet.

Locate the Kalahari Desert. It covers much of eastern Namibia and most of Botswana. Put dots inside a circle to represent sand.

Find the Southern Africa's largest lake, Lake Malawi. Shade it blue and label it with its name.

Find and label with an X the Etosha National Park in Namibia. It is home to some of the greatest numbers of lions, elephants, and rhinos in the world.
